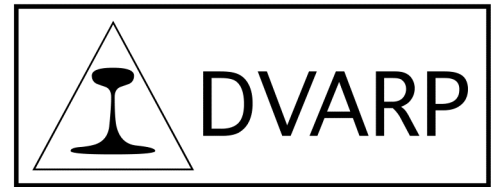

Getting there

Take any SEPTA train to Suburban Station. If you come to Philadelphia on Amtrak, your Amtrak ticket stub is good for a free ride to Suburban Station.

When you get off the train, follow the blue signs to the Market-Frankford line. Just before you get to the subway entrance, you'll see an escalator leading up to the street. Go up the escalator and 1515 Market and the Temple University entrance are immediately behind you.
